# Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of Friends of Blairs Loch (SC048921)

I report on the accounts of the charity for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> December 2021 which are set out on pages 1 and 2 of the Receipts and Payments Accounts.

#### Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities
